

## Energy Conservation Policy

Thaicom Public Company Limited operates satellite telecommunications services for domestic and foreign customers. The company considers energy conservation essential to responsible business practice. As such, it is the joint responsibility of all employees to continuously and sustainably manage and conserve energy.

Therefore, the company has adopted this energy conservation policy to be used as a guideline for ensuring the most efficient use of energy and acting in accordance with the Energy Conservation Promotion Act B.E. 2535 (Amended B.E. 2550). In this respect, the company deems it appropriate to implement such a policy for both the satellite monitoring station at Kae Rai and the ground station at Lad Lum Kaew as follows:

1. The company will conduct and develop energy conservation system properly by requiring energy conservation as part of the company's business operations.
2. The company will improve the efficiency of its energy use continuously and suitable with the company's business including implementing good practice.
3. The company will annually set plan and goals, review and improve necessary policies and operates to promote better understanding and practice among employees.
4. The company considers energy conservation the responsibility of management and employees of all levels. Cooperation is expected in regards to implementing measures and making a recommendation for the improvement of the energy conversation to the energy conservation committee.
5. The company will provide necessary support in the areas of human resources, budget planning, working hours, training and participation in making on energy improvement recommendation.

This Policy is effective from 21 March 2017 onwards.
